Exploring Spirituality in Art

Led by: Aimie Littler and Rob Pepper

Aimie and Rob are professional people who are lay members of St. Luke's Church, West Holloway where Rev Dave Tomlinson, who has led conferences for us, is the vicar.



Rob is a London-based artist who uses drawing to capture an essence of place. He draws every day, taking inspiration from his surroundings, and in doing so, has developed a fascinating, ever-changing canvas for our times. He collaborates in the conceptual development of the artwork with his partner Aimie. A senior tutor at London's Art Academy and graduate of the Birmingham Institute of

Art and Design, Rob conducts popular workshops, The Drawing Room, using art as a form of meditation. He is artist-in-residence at St. Luke's church, where he created a spectacular 40 panel artwork to decorate the chancel ceiling of the newly-renovated building.



Aimie Littler directed The Truth Isn't Sexy campaign. A campaign raising awareness about people trafficking which was launched at parliament in March 2008 to coincide with the William Wilberforce bicentennial of the abolition of the slave trade. The campaign had a high media profile and involved a proactive grass root community. She collaborates and co-facilitates with Rob Pepper for the presentations

they run together. Aimie is particularly known for her presentation of the Lord's Prayer in the Aramaic language (which Jesus spoke).

The conference will feature some of Aimie's presentation of The Lord's Prayer in conjunction with a selection of Rob's art work.

Drawing, sculpture, song, dance and any other artistic disciplines are about inner dialogue, a conversation between our inner and outer worlds. Just as our spirituality is a conversation between our inner and outer worlds. We don't always need to be told when something is spiritual, as for each of us this experience is personal and different from one to the next. Through this weekend we will offer some tools that we hope will enable us all to continue and explore our ever changing spiritual paths.

This space is about taking time for yourself using your creativity. There is no pressure and it's not about making great pieces of artwork but enjoying the process.
