Holland House is a Retreat, Conference and Laity Centre that has been used many times by EF. The main building is a beautiful old Tudor building, with well kept gardens on the banks of the River Severn, in the picturesque village of Cropthorne, Worcestershire.



Rev Benny Hazlehurst was ordained in the Church of England over 20 years ago, and is a founder Member of Accepting Evangelicals. He is married to Mel, and they have 2 children. After 15 years ministry on housing estates across South London, they now live in Dorset where Benny is a part-time Prison Chaplain. In the past he has served on General Synod and been an adviser to the Government on urban regeneration.
